PRESS RELEASE: Australian privacy powerhouses join forces

Ms Stephensen concurs and suggests that organisations can foster community trust by embedding privacy and security solutions that go beyond mere compliance. "Trust is the bedrock of relationships. Information practice that reflects this is key," she says.

Mr Trovato notes that "leadership's tone from the top can make or break an organisation's privacy and security program. At IIS, building trust has been a hallmark of our work. If an organisation wants to be trusted, it has to be trustworthy."
